# Regulations for fishing in Surna 2015

Fishing season: 1<sup>st</sup> of June – 31<sup>st</sup> of August.

## Quotes / bag limits:

**Salmon**: 1 – one – daily, 6 – six – pr. season (max. 3-three longer than 70 cm.). **In June max. 1-one** 

longer than 70 cm.

**Sea trout**: 2 – two – daily, 8 - eight pr. season.

The daily bag limit is defined as the number of salmon / sea trout one person can catch and take in one day. One day is defined according to the licence. (For week or season licenses, one day is defined as the date.) The limits are personal and cannot be transferred to others.

We require to release taken female salmons.

From July 1<sup>st</sup>, all taken female salmons have to be released.

Released fishes do not influence your personal quote. But they have to be registrated on the lists (catchingreport) by the river.

Whenever the bag limit is reached, angling must end immediately.

### Minimum measurement:

It is forbidden to take salmon or sea trout with a length of less than 35 cm.

All released fishes over minimum measurement have to be registries in the catch report.

Escaped farmed fish shall not be released. These catches shall be registries in the catch report as farmed fish, and will not influence the quote.

In doubt, the fish shall be registries as taken wild salmon.

### **Bait**

As bait, only maggot/worms, spoon, spinner, wobbler and fly are allowed. Use of false worms or shrimp is forbidden. Use of fly and sinker is not allowed.

While fishing from land it is allowed to use only one rod per fisher. Fishing from boat allows two rods. Bait with more than two hooks is not allowed. The distance between the stern and the point of the hook must not exceed 13 mm, for a single hook no greater than 15 mm. Fishing in such a manner that it is possible that the fish will be hooked is not allowed.

#### Breach of regulations.

Breaches of these regulations are considered a criminal offence, cf "LOV 1992-05-15 nr. 47: Lov om laksefisk og innlandsfisk m.v. Kap. X! §49."
