General regulations for fishing in Surna

NB: There might be some special rules for some of the different beats.

- All who have paid fishing tax can buy a fishing licence for this river. By purchasing a fishing licence, you as the buyer must have read and understood these rules.
 Breaches of these regulations are considered a criminal offence, cf LOV 1992-05-15 nr. 47: Lov om laksefisk og innlandsfisk m.v. Kap. X! §49.
- 2. Always bring your fishing licence with you while fishing.
- 3. All fishers must start their fishing at the highest point in the beat or by placed marks. All fishers must move WITH the stream 2-3 meters after each throw. This counts for both sides of the river.
- 4. All fishers must know the borders between the beats. All fishers must stop fishing before the bait reaches the next zone.
- 5. Only travel by roads or marked paths, never cross fields.
- 6. Dispose of all garbage in the nearest trashcan, not in the nature.
- 7. All fishers must report their catch. Fishing licence with catch report must be handed in.
- 8. Beat maps and lists over allowed equipments for the different beats, can be found where you bought your fishing licence.
- 9. Rule 3 does not count on spots marked for handicapped people.
- 10. Fishing from public roads and bridges is forbidden.
- 11. All fishing equipement which have been used in other water courses must be disinfected before it is used in Surna. Ask for this when purchasing fishing licence.
