Rules for fishing in Surna 2018

Season 2018: 1. June – 31. August

Everyone who are going to fish in Surna during the season of 2018 must register themselves in the registration-app or at <u>www.lakseboersen.no</u> in advance.

All salmon, both euthanized and released, must be reported in the registration-app, on the back of your Surna-card and on the areas catching-form. This must be done within 5 hours after the fish is caught.

You are not allowed to euthanize sea trout as of 2018. All caught sea trout have to be released and reported in the registration-app and on the areas catching-form. Hurt and euthanized sea trout must also be registered in the registration-app.

All female salmon above the length of 70cm must be released back into the river as of 15. July. Hurt female salmon must be euthanized and registered as "caught fish" on your personal quota.

Worms you use have to be from the local fauna or from a store in Norway. Using worms as bait is not allowed as of 15. July.

You may start your fishing as soon after you have paid tax, gotten yourself a Surna-card and zone-card, registered yourself in the app and have read and accepted the rules for fishing in Surna.

Quota for salmon:

1 salmon pr. day – 6 salmon pr. season (max 3 salmon longer than 70cm / 3kg.

Clarification of quota: It is within the regulations to euthanize 6 salmon shorter than 70cm pr. season.
